

Application for Special Consideration - JBoE

Policy

References

1. Family members and relatives, including any member of the applicant's immediate or extended family (e.g. parents, spouse, sibling, child, in-law, etc.), are not accepted as references. In exceptional circumstances, if a family member is used as a reference, an explanation must be provided. Acceptability of the reference is at the discretion of the Joint Board of Examiners.

English Language Proficiency

1. Applicants who are unable to provide IELTS, CELPIP-G or PTE test results may request special consideration.
2. Applicants must explain in at least 300 words how they became proficient in the English language.
3. The applicant's supervisor must sign the Special Consideration Form to attest to the authenticity of the applicant's submission.

Application Process

1. Applicants must apply for special consideration by completing the Special Consideration Form.
2. Applicants will not be reviewed by the Joint Board of Examiners until a completed application is submitted and has undergone the reference and review process.
